### GO- GREEN WITH CORK!



No trees are destroyed in the production of cork. Cork is produced from the bark of the tree, leaving the tree intact. The bark rejuvenates indefinitely. The trees saved produce oxygen and consume harmful greenhouse gasses. Cork is easily recycled into flooring, sports equipment, and shoes, among others. It is also naturally anti-bacterial and contains a

natural substance which enables it to be impermeable to gases and liquids. I recently purchased a high-density cork cutting board by Architec at Ketchum Kitchens. It is as durable as hardwood, plus it is sleek and created from an environmentally-sustainable material. You should try one!

### COMPUTER RECYCLING PROGRAM NOW OFFERED IN BLAINE COUNTY

On November 1, 2007 Blaine County transfer stations started accepting old computers, monitors, keyboards, cell phones and PDAs for recycling at no charge.

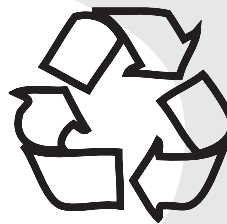
• In 2005, nearly two million tons of electronic waste ended up in landfills. Electronic waste can contain hazardous

materials such as lead, mercury, chromium, lithium and hexavalent chromium.

• Electronics contain valuable metals that can be recycled such as aluminum, steel, gold and other precious metals

Be sure to erase or encode your hard drive before recycling your computer. Make sure to remove all floppy disks, CD's and backup tapes from drives. Completely format your hard drive using a hard drive formatting program. Understand that just erasing your files using the recycle bin is not enough. ### RECYCLE YOUR CELL PHONES



Less than one percent of all cell phones are currently recycled, and there are 500 million used cell phones not being used in the United States.<sup>[1]</sup> You can now drop them off at either the Ohio Gulch Transfer Station or the Carey Transfer Station.
