Your City Council has changed the way that garbage services are handled and Clear Creek Disposal (CCD) is excited to enlighten you of these new changes. Garbage collection service now includes recycling service. As well, all residents of Sun Valley will continue to have the same unlimited household trash service with convenient rolling carts.

Tips

How to take advantage of your service:

Read all of the information contained in this mailing and then call our office to order your bins and or carts. Please note that only the first trip for delivery or pickup of items is included in your service.

GARBAGE SERVICE

All garbage shall be contained in a CCD provided cart. If you have the need for additional rolling cart(s), just call the CCD office, there is no extra charge. An occasional box or bag will be picked up if not placed in the carts, however if the need arises we will contact you for more carts due to consistent extra garbage.

Collection day is Tues-

day. Please place to the street by 7:00 am with the lid opening facing the street.

Christmas trees will be collected on the first two service days following Christmas for chipping. Place them to

the street free of ornaments, decorations, lights, and tree stand. No cutting of the tree will be necessary on these two collection days only.



RECYCLE SERVICE

There are six categories or commodities for recycling:

- Glass**
- Aluminum & tin**
- Paper**
- Plastics Bottles: #1 & #2**
- Newspaper**
- Magazines**

Recycling service includes up to six stackable bins for your convenience. Each bin is for one of the categories or commodities to be collected at your home and to be transported to the street for collection by

7:00 am. Mixed items will not be collected. These "stackable" bins are made to be convenient and allow space to place items into the bins without having to un-stack or move anything. Please tailor the bins to your own personal needs as there is no obligation of the items that you choose to recycle; any combination is acceptable.

In an effort to help you optimize your re-

cycling efforts, we have some suggestions to assist you in hauling your curbside recyclables to the street.

RECYCLE WAGON

NEW NEWS

Since paper recycling is so important, here are some new changes in recycling:
We can now recycle more paper products!



Paper recycle includes junk mail, all office paper, envelopes, file folders, packing paper, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, paper bags, wrapping paper, etc.

NO spiral binding, hardcover books, tyvek envelopes, pizza boxes, coffee cups or milk/soy-milk cartons, and carbon.

HELPFUL HINTS

- Place rolling garbage carts on one side of the driveway and recyclables on the other.
- Leave approximately one foot in-between multiple carts.
- At the street, place any recyclable items that cannot be blown-out of the bin on top of items that can be blown around by the wind.
- Check www.ccdisposal.com often for recycling, garbage, and holiday information and schedules.
- Do not place any items to the street the night before a snow storm because the plow trucks will make a mess for you to clean up.

and can easily be wheeled to the curb. You can order them direct from Environmental Assist at (408) 734-8002 or www.environmentalassist.com.

Check local hardware stores for a moving apparatus that suits your individual needs.

You may choose to use the "old system" of an 18 gallon bin with recyclables being sorted using bags, however the bags will be left in the bin after emptying.

CARDBOARD RECYCLING

There are dumpsters labeled cardboard only for you to recycle your card-

board at the Sun Valley City Hall and the Elkhorn Fire Station. We ask that you break down your boxes before you put them into the dumpsters. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated!

PHONE BOOK RECYCLING

During the month of November only dumpsters for phone book recycling will also be placed at the Sun Valley City Hall and the Elkhorn Fire Station. Just deposit your old phone books into one of these dumpsters and we will take care of the rest.
